

NOTICE OF PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE Central Huron Official Plan Review

Members of the Central Huron community are invited to participate in Public Open House sessions to discuss draft changes to the Central Huron Official Plan. These are drop-in sessions where the public will have an opportunity to review draft policies and mapping, ask questions of Planning staff and provide comments.

The Official Plan is a land use planning document that is a statement of where and how building and development should take place. The Plan includes the vision, goals and policy directions for development in Central Huron.
