Position Details

Position status (Full time, part time, seasonal, or contract): Full time

A – RESPONSIBILITIES (includes accountabilities)

1) Scope of Position

- To be able to operate tandem axel truck (with snow plow, sander, water tank and dump attachments), graders (for grading, snow plowing and ice blading), loader, backhoe, sweeper, trackless sidewalk machine, pickup truck, tractor, chain saws, wood chipper, mini excavator, line painter, packer roller other power and hand tools to provide safe roads for the Municipality.
- Assist other departments with various projects throughout the municipality (e.g.) Community Improvement projects, Facilities projects, Utilities projects. Staff assistance is subject to Roads Manager's approval prior to commencement.
- Maintaining proper health and safety is paramount importance in this position. Expected to
 follow all Government health and safety legislation statutes and acts as well as all municipal
 policies to ensure a safe working environment for all. Responsible to exercise good
 judgement, working individually or as a member of a team and following safe work practices to
 address issues which are more minor in nature at the work site.
- To have good communication and public relations skills in order to deal tactfully with the public.
- Working cooperatively with other road department staff on day to day tasks.

2) Key Responsibilities

Operations & Program Delivery Maintenance of Equipment

Maintains equipment, vehicles and tools in safe operating condition by following acceptable
maintenance and servicing schedules in accordance with municipal, provincial and federal
requirements where applicable as well as manufacture suggestions.

Maintenance of All Roads

 Provide all general maintenance for the roads gravel and asphalt, drainage, and storm systems and catch basin repair, signs, sidewalk maintenance and repair, garbage and leaf bag pick up, line painting, cemetery assistance, compost site maintenance and document all maintenance performed.

Snow Removal

- All snow and ice removal and prevention of all Municipally owned roads, sidewalks and parking lots
- Patrolling roads and recording of time, distance, conditions
- Perform weekend work when required. In addition, schedule may be adjusted to winter hours.

Cutting and Trimming of Trees

 Removal of dead trees and limbs for the public's safety as per the direction of the Road's Foreperson. Record keeping of all tree and limb maintenance.

Documentation

 Documentation of all tasks is a primary element of this role. All documentation (equipment maintenance, tree maintenance, road maintenance, road conditions, etc.) should be updated as the tasks are performed or conditions are assessed. At a minimum record should be updated on a daily basis.

Health & Safety

 Work in a safe manner and in accordance with all Government statutes legislation and Acts and within Central Huron's policies and procedures.

Other

Minimal mainly with local vendor for parts and supplies

Internal

- Roads Manger daily/weekly- interpersonal and written important relay of work flow effecting both parties
- Roads Foreman interpersonal daily- important relay of work flow effecting both parties
- Utilities department, Community Improvement and Facilities- as needed importantinterpersonal - jobs affecting both departments
- Cemetery- daily- interpersonal and written- helping with maintenance and burials

Public Relations

Deal with the public on a daily basis in a calm courteous and helpful way

C - EFFORT & WORKING CONDITIONS

1) Physical Effort and Environment

• Sitting, standing, walking, lifting, and general labour

2) Mental Effort and Environment

- Most work is performed outdoors with frequent exposure to potential hazards when maintaining and constructing municipal infrastructure or roads works operations.
- May be required to work in inclement weather conditions such as blizzards, whiteouts, ice storms, fog, etc.
- Works overtime and unusual work hours as required responding to emergencies and poor weather conditions. Incumbent may be required to be on call as directed.
